

Zorgniotti Fund 2022 – Summary proposed project from SLAMS

The purpose of this project is to support continuing education in sexual medicine and foster development of expertise in this field. The funding is intended to supplement continuing education and participation in symposium and webinars. In this project it will be disseminate current and useful concepts to treat patients with sexual pathologies that will be dictated by specialists in Sexual Medicine, who have strived to provide the best of current knowledge in a program useful for all health professionals in Sexual Medicine. These activities will be developed in countries in which sexual medicine needs to be encouraged and extended.

The board of directors of SLAMS will coordinate among Bolivian, Paraguayan and Peruvian members and non-members of SLAMS. If approved, the following information may be used in our program of continuing education: “This project is endorsed by the International Society for Sexual Medicine (ISSM) - Grants from Zorgniotti - Foundation”.

The target audience will include urologists, internists, cardiologists, endocrinologists, gynecologists, family doctors, psychologists, sex therapists, students of the health field from Latin America. The expect number of attenders in this project including Webinars and Symposia (on-line and in person) will be approximately 400 attendees. The official language of the Symposia will be Spanish while in the Webinars the languages will Portuguese and Spanish.

The speakers of the Symposia will be 3 members from each country (Paraguay, Bolivia and Peru) and 1 or 2 invited members from the other countries. The duration of this scientific meeting will 1 day (all day long). In the two Webinars, with duration of 1 hour each one, there are 3 speakers (members of SLAMS). In the Scientific Program the following topics are discussed: erectile dysfunction, ejaculation disorders, Peyronie´s disease, priapism, testosterone replacement therapy, female sexual dysfunction, sexual violence in Latin America, and sexual health of adolescents.

All speakers and moderators invited to participate in symposia and webinars will be members of SLAMS and will not receive any financial compensation (fee) for their participation. For better logistics of accommodation and venue of events, we will try to hold the symposia in a hotel that does not characterize a Resort, so we will provide accommodation, airfare and meals to our speakers.
